

CHINON CLASSIC REGULATIONS JUNE 21, 22 and 23, 2024

Article 1.

The Chinon Classic Association organises.

- A HISTORIC TOURIST RALLY, without fixed times or imposed averages, reserved for classic cars from 1900 to 1994 (over 30 years old)
- A PRESENTATION OF CLASSIC CARS AND MOTORCYCLES ON CLOSED ROADS IN CHINON

The Rally complies with the general provisions of the Fédération Internationale des Véhicules Anciens (F.I.V.A.). It is in no way a sporting event. Its purpose is to allow collectors of vintage vehicles to drive their vehicles in optimal safety conditions and to highlight, by showcasing and bringing to life, the industrial heritage that these vehicles constitute. It also promotes the discovery of the landscape, architectural, cultural and historical heritage of our regions. The Rally is organised so that each participant, whatever the age and the capacity of their vehicle, can complete the route in good safety conditions.

It takes place on the open road, in compliance with the Highway Code, with the aim of not disturbing the circulation of other road users or the tranquility of local residents and will not give rise to any classification based on navigation and/or regularity.

The departure of participants is staggered so as not to disrupt road traffic.

Article 2 Cars Eligible for the Event

All old cars in perfect working order, whose characteristics conform to the original, being more than 30 years old (unless exceptional exemption granted by the organisers). The Rally is also open to "SUPERCAR" cars less than 30 years old. The CHINON CLASSIC association reserves the right to refuse any vehicle which does not conform to the spirit of the event. Any change of vehicle must be immediately reported to the organisers who reserve the right to accept or refuse the said vehicle.

Article 3 Obligations

Participants must comply with the requirements of the highway code, municipal and prefectural laws, as well as the articles of these regulations. In addition, they must respect the signaling that may be made by the marshals.

The visible rally plate is compulsory on the vehicle and must in no case obscure the vehicle registration.

Article 4 Insurance

In accordance with the requirements of decrees 2006.554 of 16/05/2006, and its application orders of 07/08/2006 and 27/10/2006, a policy will be taken out to guarantee (in the event of an accident, fire or explosion occurring during the events) the financial consequences of civil liability that may be incumbent on the organisers and the participants, due to bodily injury or material damage caused to spectators, third parties or the participants themselves. This policy also guarantees civil liability towards the people responsible for security or participants in the organisation and control of the event.

It is up to participants to check with their insurers that their various insurance contracts remain valid for the duration of the Rally. If this is not the case, it is their responsibility to take all measures to cover the driver and navigator against the risks of the Rally.

Article 5 Advertising

The organisers reserve the right to make the agreements they deem useful with the advertising brands of their choice and to affix this advertising on the plates bearing the numbers of the participants or on the cars. Any other publicity, other than that decided by the organisers, is strictly prohibited (unless agreed by the organisers).

Article 6 Distribution of documents

Participants will report to the reception to collect the necessary documents (program, detailed itinerary, rally plate), as desired.

- -FRIDAY at 2:00 p.m.,
- -SATURDAY from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
- -SUNDAY from 8 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

Article 7 Procedure

The event will take place in the tradition of courtesy and friendliness which are the rule among classic car enthusiasts.

THE TOURISTIC RALLY

The touristic rally will include a route which will mainly take secondary roads in our region.

The start will be given at 8:45 a.m. on Saturday. Participants in the rally do so under their sole responsibility, as it is a touristic rally, without any sporting aspect.

PRESENTATIONS / DEMONSTRATIONS

Only motorcycles and cars registered for the event before May 10 will be able to participate in the demonstrations on Saturday afternoon and Sunday. This is a presentation of homologous vehicles in series of 20 to 30 (in no case of speed or regularity tests). The participants will present themselves in the pre-grid a quarter of an hour before the start of their series. Out of respect for the public and sponsors, unless agreed by the organisation, participants undertake to stay throughout the entire Sunday event.

Registration of cars for the Sunday demonstration only is limited to pre-war vehicles or by selection of the organisation.

Article 8 Entries:

No entry or registration will be made over the phone.

Only the registration document available on https://www.chinonclassic.com, received by the organisation will be registered. Your participation in the event will only be taken into account once payment has been received, a confirmation of entry will then be sent to you. All requests for participation must be sent to:

For the first participation, a photo of the vehicle is mandatory. For the Saturday rally, as soon as the maximum number of participants is reached, entries will be closed, according to the reception capacities of the various places visited. The organisers reserve the right to select entries, giving priority to pre-war vehicles and vehicles prior to 1960 and refusing any vehicle that does not correspond to the spirit of the event.

Article 9 Payment:

- => in cash: for foreigners who wish, send a deposit cheque in the currency of the country replaced by cash on the day of the event.

Article 10 Cancellation conditions:

Any cancellation by the participant must be notified in writing (mail or email) before 10th. June in order to obtain a refund of the amounts paid. In the event of cancellation after this date, no refund will be made. All cases not provided for in these regulations will be decided by the organising committee, comprising the officials of Chinon Classic.
